

SECTION 18: Enforcement Agency

The Town of Lenox Department of Building Inspection, plan review and inspection personnel and other personnel officers and personnel and consultants of the Town of Lenox Department of Building Inspection and other personnel in the Town of Lenox and enforcement of the State Construction Code and Act, the safety of the building and the responsibility of the Township to enforce and enforce the State Construction Code and Act.

SECTION 19: Final Plan Enforcement

The Township Building Official shall conduct the review for permit issuance pursuant to Section 1906 of the state construction code. Upon receipt of any proposed development in the Township with the final permit issued on the final inspection report (FIS) and final review of the plans (FIR) set forth in this chapter. The Township Building Official shall enforce the provisions of the State Construction Code as

SECTION 20: Fees

Permit and related fees for enforcement of the State Construction Code shall be as currently established or as hereafter adopted by resolution of the Township Board from time to time.

SECTION 21: Investigative Board of Appeals

A board of appeals shall be created and consist of three members and shall be appointed by the Township Board for five-year terms. The Board of Appeals is given the power and duties set forth in Public Act No. 137 of 1972 (MCL 158.1501 et seq.).

SECTION 22: Violations

Any person who is found guilty of violating any provision of the State Construction Code or any other applicable Township Ordinance, shall be deemed to be in violation of the State Construction Code and any other applicable Township Ordinance. In addition, any building or structure erected, used, moved, demolished, altered or maintained in violation of the State Construction Code shall be deemed to be a nuisance per se. Upon application to a court of competent jurisdiction, the court may order the nuisance abated or the violation of the State Construction Code or any other applicable Township Ordinance enjoined.
