PART 67: ORDINANCE NO. 14

#### MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT BY REFERENCE THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923, AS AMENDED

#### THE TOWNSHIP OF LENOX ORDAINS:

# **SECTION 1: Michigan Vehicle Code Adopted.**

The Michigan Vehicle Code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923, as amended, and all future amendments and revisions to the Michigan Vehicle Code when they are effective in this state are incorporated and adopted by reference.

## **SECTION 2: References in Michigan Vehicle Code.**

References in the Michigan Vehicle Code to "local authorities" shall mean the Township of Lenox.

### **SECTION 3: Notice to be Published.**

The Township Clerk shall publish this ordinance in the manner required by law and shall publish, at the same time, a notice stating the purpose of the Michigan Vehicle Code and the fact that a complete copy of the Michigan Vehicle Code is available to the public at the office of the clerk for inspection.

#### **SECTION 4: Penalties.**

Violations of the Michigan Vehicle Code for which the maximum period of imprisonment is greater than ninety-three (93) days shall not be enforced by the Township as an ordinance violation; provided, however, a violation of MCL 257.625(1)(c) shall constitute a misdemeanor punishable by one (1) or more of the following: community service for not more than three hundred sixty (360) hours, imprisonment for not more than one hundred eighty (180) days, and/or a fine of not less than two hundred dollars (\$200.00) or more than seven hundred dollars (\$700.00).

## **SECTION 5: Severability.**

If any section, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared to be unconstitutional, void, illegal or ineffective by any Court of competent jurisdiction, the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or in part, shall not be affected other than the part invalidated, and such section, clause or provision declared to be unconstitutional, void or illegal shall thereby cease to be a part of this Ordinance, but the remainder of this Ordinance shall stand and be in full force and effect.

# SECTION 6: Repealer.

Any other ordinances inconsistent with the Michigan Vehicle Code, including Part 67, Ordinance 4, Driving While License Suspended (DWLS) and Part 67, Ordinance 9, Operating While Under the Influence of Liquor (OUIL), are hereby repealed.

# SECTION 7: Savings.

All proceedings pending and all rights and liabilities existing, acquired or incurred at the time this ordinance takes effect, are saved and may be consummated according to the law in force when they were commenced.

### **SECTION 8: Publication and Effective Date.**

This ordinance, or a summary hereof, shall be published within 30 days of adoption in a newspaper of general circulation in Lenox Township and shall become effective 30 days after such publication, as provided by law.

## **Enactment**

This ordinance is declared to have been enacted by the Township Board of Trustees of the Township of Lenox at a meeting called and held on the 5th day of October, 2015, and ordered to be given publication in the manner prescribed by law.
